6. Mention the <b>two angles</b> from which the believer <i>'remembers Allaah'</i> at the time of committing a sin [3:135].
7. <b>Memorize</b> the supplication which the Prophet (علية referred to as <b>'Sayyid al-Istighfaar'</b> . [Define this expression]

9. Discuss the Prophet's (علي (علي ) explanation of <b>what</b> would be the <b>cause</b> of a person leaving the fold of Islaam in one day.

6. Discuss the <b>attitude/approach</b> of the <u>Sah</u> aabah (RadiyAllaahu 'an-hum) towards <b>knowledge</b> (evidenced in this <u>H</u> adeeth).
7. Discuss how many people today <b>differ</b> from the <u>Sah</u> aabah (RadiyAllaahu 'an-hum) in their approach towards knowledge.
8. 'The one who is <b>ignorant</b> is better than one who <b>does not act</b> upon his <b>knowledge</b> .' Is this a good reason to rema ignorant? Explain!
9. <b>Memorize</b> the <u>H</u> adeeth which is a <b>proof</b> that <b>Allaah Alone Knows</b> who has been wounded (or killed) <b>'Fee Sabeelillaah'</b> .
10. Discuss the main factor which determines who is a Shaheed - which is something not known to a human being.

3. How has the Shaykh (Ra <u>h</u> imahullaah) explained the <b>relationship</b> between one being both ' <u>Saheeh</u> ' and 'Sha <u>h</u> ee <u>h</u> ' - and why a healthy person would be in a state of 'fearing poverty'?
4. Discuss the <b>additional advice</b> given by the Prophet (عليه وسلم) with which he (عليه وسلم) <b>concluded</b> his response to this question.
5. Mention the <b>main point</b> derived from this <u>H</u> adeeth that <i>directly relates</i> to the subject of this chapter.
6. How has <b>Allaah</b> described the <b>scene</b> of the <b>Mujrimoon</b> once <b>Malakul-Mawt</b> takes their souls & returns them to Allaah?
7. Mention a <b>second point</b> derived from this <u>H</u> adeeth that is an <b>extension</b> of the first point.
8. Mention a <b>secondary point</b> derived from this <u>H</u> adeeth, which is <b>not</b> directly related to the subject of this chapter.
9. Mention the <b>Daleel</b> - in this <u>H</u> adeeth - which indicates that the <b>Roo<u>h</u></b> comes from the <b>lower</b> part of the body to the <b>upper</b> part of the body, and then is <b>taken</b> (by Malakul-Mawt) from there.

7. How has the Shaykh (Rahimahullaah) explained the cause of this increase in evil which destroys the people & society?
8. Discuss the statement of Shaykhul-Islaam ibn Taymiyyah (Rahimahullaah) <b>comparing wealth</b> to the <b>toilet</b> or a <b>donkey</b> .
9. Discuss the main point derived from this <u>H</u> adeeth & the <b>consolation</b> for those who have been <b>wronged in the Dunyaa</b> .

5. List <b>three</b> (3) <b>other points</b> mentioned by the Shaykh (Rahimahullaah) concerning <b>ad-Dajjaal</b> .
6. <b>Memorize</b> the Aayah mentioned by the Shaykh (Rahimahullaah) [54:46] concerning the <b>appointed hour</b> of Judgment.
7. Discuss the <b>main point</b> which is to be taken from this <u>H</u> adeeth.

4. Discuss 2 virtues mentioned by the Shaykh (هم مه) for the statement: Laa ilaaha illAllaah wa Muhammadur-Rasoolullaah.
5. This <b>Shahaadah</b> protects one's blood & wealth except <b>bi-<u>H</u>aqqi-haa</b> . <u>Explain</u> : ' <b>bi-<u>H</u>aqqi-haa'</b> & the example of the <b>key</b> .
6. Discuss (with an example) the <b>condition</b> of those who <b>pronounce</b> the <b>Shahaadatain</b> while engaging in <b>Kufr</b> .
7. <b>Memorize</b> Aayah 63:1 and <b>explain why</b> Allaah declares the <b>Munaafiqoon</b> to be <b>Kaadhiboon</b> (liars) while they are swearing that Muhammad (مَالَيْكُ ) is the Messenger of Allaah.
8. Give an <b>example</b> from Islamic History which shows the <b>permissibility</b> of fighting Muslims who pronounce the <b>Shahaadah</b> .
9. Explain the Prophet's (مثياليه) <b>speaking</b> about giving the <b>Raayah</b> to someone <b>tomorrow</b> - <u>without</u> saying: <b>In Shaa Allaah</b> !
