4. Mention some of the other rights which - when joined with the Haqq (right) of the elderly - magnify it.

5. What was said to Abu Bakr (RadiyAllāhu 'anhu) when he brought his elderly father to the Prophet (علي اله) to accept Islām?

6. Mention the effect of kind/respectful speech upon the soul & heart of the elderly when addressing them.

7. Mention the Ayah [31:15] which clearly states the right of parents to be treated kindly, even if they are Mushriks.

8. Summarize the righteous deed, related to rights of the elderly, mentioned by one of the 3 people blocked in the cave.

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1. Mention one of the best books which contain textual evidence of the importance of the Rights of the Elderly.

2. What does the author say this book also contains related to the generation of the Sahābah (RadiyAllāhu 'anhum)?

3. Discuss the Mushkilah (problem) which the author says we are 'afflicted with' [of suffer from] in our practical life.

4. What would be the results - mentioned in 4:66-68 - if the believers just do what we are told/instructed to do?

5. Summarize the incident of the man who went to scold the Khateeb of the central Masjid & the Khateeb's response.

6. From this story the author explains that the role of the Khateeb is to do what?

7. So what does the author say is the role of the person who is listening to the Khutbah?
