1. Discuss the *twentieth characteristic* of the Prophets (AlaihimusSalaam) mentioned by the author (Hafidhahullaah).
2. **Memorize** the **Hadeeth Qudsee** mentioned by the author showing the importance of having **Husnu-dh-Dhann** with Allaah.
3. Discuss briefly the **meaning** of the above **Hadeeth Qudsee** - especially the explanation of Haafidh Ibn Hajar al-Asqalaanee (Rahimahullaah).
4. Discuss the **foundation** upon which **Shu'aib** (AlaihisSalaam) was able to **put his trust in Allaah Alone**. [Qur'aan 7:89]
5. **Memorize** the statement of **Moosaa** (AlaihisSalaam) to his people when Fir'awn intended to destroy them [Qur'aan 7:128].
6. Mention the **three qualities** mentioned by **Moosaa** (AlaihisSalaam) due to which his people would be rescued from Fir'awn.
7. Mention the **response** of **Moosaa** (AlaihisSalaam) when his people thought they would be overtaken by Fir'awn's army, and what his (AlaihisSalaam) words **indicate?** [Qur'aan, 26:61, 62]
