1. Give a comprehensive definition of **ash-Shukr** (gratitude) [like the one given by Ibn al-Qayyim (rahimahullaah)].
2. Complete Allaah's *description* of **Nooh** (AlaihisSalaam): 'Innahu Kaana ' ('Indeed, he was ' [Qur'aan 17:3].
3. Mention Allaah's *description* of **Ibraaheem** (AlaihisSalaam) as being **grateful**... [in Soorah an-Nahl 16:120, 121]
4. **Memorize** the supplication of **Sulaimaan** (AlaihisSalaam) asking Allaah to enable him to be **grateful** for His favors [27:19].
5. Mention the **great favor** of Allaah upon **Moosaa** (AlaihisSalaam) for which He commanded him to be **grateful**. [7:144]
6. **Memorize** the *response* of Prophet **Muḥammad** (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) to the fact that *his sins are all forgiven*.
