#### Questionnaire-Study Guide: Lecture No. 11

1. **Memorize** the Tenth statement of the **author** (رحمه الله) which relates to the rights of **parents, relatives, neighbors** etc.
2. List the seven (7) groups of people singled out here by the **author** (رحمه الله) for good treatment.
3. **Memorize** the **Aayah** [4:36] which points to the **importance** of the **rights of parents**.
4. Discuss the Shaykh's **explanation** of how the **rights of the Messenger of Allaah** (صلى الله عليه وسلم) are included in the above **Aayah**.
5. Discuss briefly **why** the **mother** has more right to a person's **good companionship** than anyone else, including the father.
6. Clarify the ruling concerning '**being dutiful to parents**' and a **Daleel** from **Sunnah** showing its preference over **Jihaad**.
7. Define the word **al-Birr** (as it relates to parents), mentioning its 2 aspects, & explaining the *details of the first* of them.
8. Discuss the **difference** between the rights of **parents (Waalidain)** and the rights of other **relatives (al-Arhaam)**.
9. Why must we refer to the **customs ('Urf)** of the people to determine what is considered to be '**keeping ties**' (**Silah**)?
10. Discuss the Shaykh's (رحمه الله) two examples of '**keeping ties**' (**Silah**) - under two different circumstances.
