**Questionnaire-Study Guide: Lecture No. 3**

1. **Memorize** the Aayah in which Allaah mentions: 'those who have been given the Book recite it **Haqqa Tilaawatih**...' [2:121]
  
2. Mention briefly the three matters without which this '**Haqqa Tilaawatih**' will not be complete and perfect.
  
3. Discuss briefly, what **should** and what **should not** be the **concerns** of the person while reciting the Qur'aan.
  
4. Discuss the statement of al-'Allamah Ibnul-Qayyim (رحمه الله) concerning **reading** the Qur'aan with **reflection**.
  
5. Mention the **Aayah** which is reported to have been recited by the Prophet (ﷺ) in his **Qiyaam** for the whole night.
  
6. Discuss the story of a man who recited **Soorah al-Ikhl** for an entire night. [Hadeeth Abu Sa'eed al-Khudree (رضي الله عنه)]
  
7. **Memorize** the statement of **Imaam al-Hasan al-Basree** (رحمه الله) concerning the **purpose** for which the Qur'aan was revealed.
  
8. Mention a **daleel** that **al-Ittibaa'** (following) - or **acting** upon the Qur'aan - is one of the meanings of **at-Tilaawah**.
  
9. Discuss the statement of Ibn Mas'ood (رضي الله عنه) concerning what is expected of a believer when he hears: '**O You who believe...**'
